Onan's eternal images coming to Ankara

Urkish photographer Timurtas Onan opens his solo photo exhibition in Ankara this Thursday. The exhibition titled "Eternal Images" features a collection of classical images by Onan. It will be held at the Contemporary Arts Center and can be visited until April 10. The TDN interviewed Timurtas Onan about his exhibition, his future plans and new projects.

In this exhibition nearly 30 huge photos will be exhibited. The photos were collected from the last 20 years of his work and many of them have received awards both in national and international competitions. Onan prints his photos in limited numbers and does not sell more than 10 copies of each.

The exhibition does not focus on a single subject, the only thing common in this exhibition is that the photos were taken in Turkey and most of them portray people living in Anatolia

The photographs were also exhibiited in a joint exhibition with British
sculptor, David Cregeen. This exhibition toured Istanbul, Adana,
Çanakkale, Edirne, Balıkesir and
Izmir before arriving in Ankara.

His exhibition can also be viewed online from www.timurtasonan.com. His other exhibition will also be available on the net very soon. An opening ceremony will be organized on April 1 and Onan will sign his booklet as a part of the opening.

Onan has another upcoming project with David Cregeen. "In August we plan to go Edinburgh for another exhibition. A traditional yoruk tent will be placed in the university's garden, adorned with the latest light technologies and we will display David's sculptures with my photos. Previously we organized a similar exhibition in Antalya titled 'Old City for Sale' and we showed the destruction of the old quarters of Antalya which brought attention by media as well as people living there," said Onan.

Another Onan's projects is to organize a genuine exhibition in Istanbul. He plans to place huge photos on buildings in different districts so that while touring the exhibition the viewers will also tour Istanbul and learn more about the city.


Who is Timurtas Onan?

Onan's photography has received ever increasing recognition; winning prizes for his work both at home and abroad. For the past fifteen years he has also been engaged in photographic work in the tourism and industrial sectors as well as for important magazine publications. In 1990 he moved from Istanbul to Antalya and in 1996 he founded the Antalya Photography Days. In 1998 his contributions to the cultural life of the city were recognized by the Antalya Art Association. Nationally and internationally he has taken part in more than 100 exhibitions and other photographic activities. He is a member of the Antalya Photography and Cinema Amateurs Club, the Istanbul Photographic and Cinema



FIAP (Federation Internationale de L'art Photographique). In April 2000, along with the Turkish based and internationally recognized British sculptor David Cregeen, he exhibited his works at the Ziraat Bank Tunel Art Galery, a joint exhibition which was estitled "Eternal Image." In 2001, 2002, and 2003 he showed his photographic presentation "Outsiders" and his exhibition section of the exhibition "Eternal Image" at the

Photograhy and Art Festival, Istanbul Slide days, Cyprus Photograph Days, the 1st Istanbul Symposium o photography, Canakkale Photograph Days, Edirne Fine Arts Gallery & Izmir Municipality Art Gallery.
